### *Prices / Vintages*

- All prices quoted are Singapore duty paid, subject to prevailing Singapore Goods and Services Tax.
- Vintages are correct at the time of printing. However, vintages are subject to change without prior notice.

### *Invoices / Payment*

- The customer shall notify Certain Cellars Pte Ltd of any discrepancies or relating to any invoices issued by Certain Cellars Pte Ltd within 48 hours of receipt of such invoice, failing which the customer shall be deemed to have accepted the goods as accurate in all aspect.
- Upon signing the invoice / delivery order, the customer accepts and confirms that the goods have been inspected, are according to descriptions and are otherwise in good order and condition.
- Unless the customer has an approved trading account with Certain Cellars Pte Ltd, payment has to be made in full at the time of delivery or prior to the delivery. Certain Cellars Pte Ltd shall reserve the rights to retain the goods, without prejudice to any of its other rights.

- The legal and beneficial title to the goods shall remain solely and absolutely with Certain Cellars Pte Ltd until full payment for the goods is received.
- A late payment interest at a rate of 8% per month shall be imposed on any outstanding amount due on the invoice, from the date of delivery.
- If payment is made by the way of cheque, the cheque should be crossed and make payable to “Certain Cellars Pte Ltd”.

### *Delivery / Orders*

- Delivery is complimentary for S\$200/- and above per destination, otherwise an S\$20 surcharge per delivery per destination is applicable.
- Deliveries are from Mondays to Fridays, between 1000 hrs to 1700 hrs, exclude public holidays and eve.
- Orders placed by 1500 hrs, delivery will be made on next working day.
- Orders placed after 1500 hrs, delivery will be made 2 working days later.
